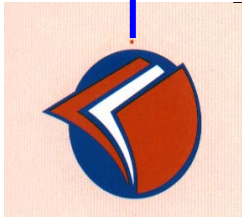

Video shows the dangers faced by a young couple who are lured into Smuggling illegal drugs back to Canada for quick money. They find out that the risks and consequences of drug involvement are much greater than they had anticipated.

Illustrates the impact driving under the influence of alcohol or other drugs has on our society. It addresses the effects of alcohol and prescription drugs on a driver's judgment and motor skills, and the consequences of choosing to drive under the influence. Through open and candid interviews, victims talk about the impact a drunk driver made in their lives. (NOT RECOMMENDED FOR CHILDREN)

This video portrays the personal tragedies of five families who have been affected by impaired drivers. This is an educational tool which will be utilized at the secondary and senior school levels with MADD Canada's Close to Home Program.

**Low level BAC Impairment goggles** [kit] [arr]

These goggles demonstrate effects of impairment, including reduced alertness, slowed reaction time, confusion, visual distortion, alteration of depth & distance perception, reduction of peripheral vision, poor judgment and decision making, double vision, and lack of muscular coordination. These goggles simulate a BAC of .04 to .06. Can be used for peer education and mentoring programs as well as at shopping malls and fairs or to supplement alcohol and drug abuse prevention and awareness programs.

He challenges today's young people to be the generation which rejects this destructive behaviour forever.

Narrated by Barbara Lee Edwards, this video deals with drinking and driving and the devastating effects it leaves on families and friends who have lost loved ones as a result of an impaired driver. Stresses the importance of not driving while under the influence of alcohol and of having a designated driver.

Features four subjects - three young women and one young man - who will drive a predetermined course in a dual controlled driver training vehicle under the direct supervision of a member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police. The purpose of this experiment is to demonstrate the significant changes in the driving habits of the individuals after the consumption of relatively minor amounts of alcohol and how the BAC levels in all four subjects varied. Other topics discussed are peer pressure, messages about alcohol and cost of a Driving While Impaired conviction in Manitoba.

The module includes six individual units dealing with decision-making, the effects of alcohol and other drugs, the legal and human consequences of impaired driving, and prevention strategies. **Social and behavioral consequences of alcohol dependence**

This program describes how alcohol abuse can affect a drinker's personality and distort his or her sense of values and priorities. Discusses issues such as absenteeism, hiding alcohol and lying about its use, the breakdown of relationships, as well as illegal activities, particularly drinking and driving.

Wheels is a drama about students, cars, partying and friendship. Like other teenagers, the main characters make choices while facing the realities of peer pressure. They must also face the consequences of their actions.

Targeting youth, this video addresses the serious social issue of impaired driving. It portrays the dilemma faced by Julie when her friend, who has been drinking, insists that she can drive. Julie, who doesn't drive, has some difficult choices to make. While the drama unfolds, people who have experienced personal tragedy, resulting from impaired driving, share their stories. SADD, students working to prevent impaired driving, are also featured. (NOT RECOMMENDED FOR CHILDREN)
