Drive alive : a new look at drinking and driving and teens (ajki)

The teen program is divided into five sections. Each section can be used on its own or in combination with any other section. The resource guide for parent groups is composed of lecture material and a discussion guide. The key issues involved are understanding the motivations and circumstances that affect teens' discussions regarding drinking and driving. The videotape portrays the activities that various Alberta teen groups have undertaken in response to the drinking and driving issue.

Drugs and driving : double trouble (ajfx)

Friends don't let friends (ajha)

Illustrates the impact driving under the influence of alcohol or other drugs has on our society. Through open and candid interviews, victims talk about the impact a drunk driver made in their lives. **(NOT RECOMMENDED FOR CHILDREN)**

Kevin Hollinsky : consequences (akdv)

Low level BAC impairment goggles (arrr)

These goggles demonstrate effects of impairment, including reduced alertness, slowed reaction time, confusion, visual distortion, alteration of depth & distance perception, reduction of peripheral vision, poor judgment and decision making, double vision, and lack of muscular coordination. The simulate a BAC of .04 to .06. Can be used for peer education and mentoring programs as well as at shopping malls and fairs or to supplement alcohol and drug abuse prevention and awareness programs.

Making the leap to high school (auah)

No time to say goodbye (allp)

Narrated by Barbara Lee Edwards, this video deals with drinking and driving and the devastating effects it leaves on families and friends who have lost loved ones as a result of an impaired driver. Stresses the importance of not driving while under the influence of alcohol and of having a designated driver.

A hands-on driver-training program stressing the importance of driving impairment free.

One too many! (alil)

Features four subjects – three young women and one young man – who will drive a predetermined course in a dual controlled driver training vehicle under the direct supervision of a member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police. The purpose of this experiment is to demonstrate the significant changes in the driving habits of the individuals after the consumption of relatively minor amounts of alcohol and how the BAC levels in all four subjects varied. Other topics discussed are peer pressure, messages about alcohol and cost of a Driving While Impaired conviction in Manitoba.

“ . . . or it could be you ” (ajqi)

This program describes how alcohol abuse can affect a drinker's personality and distort his or her sense of values and priorities. Discusses issues such as absenteeism, hiding alcohol and lying about its use, the breakdown of relationships, as well as illegal activities, particularly drinking and driving.

Wheels (ajbv)

Wheels is a drama about students, cars, partying and friendship. Like other teenagers, the main characters make choices while facing the realities of peer pressure. They must also face the consequences of their actions.

Targeting youth, this video addresses the serious social issue of impaired driving. It portrays the dilemma faced by Julie when her friend, who has been drinking, insists that she can drive. Julie, who doesn't drive, has some difficult choices to make. While the drama unfolds, people who have experienced personal tragedy, resulting from impaired driving, share their stories. SADD, students working to prevent impaired driving, are also featured. **(NOT RECOMMENDED FOR CHILDREN).**

Wrecked : high school anti-impaired driving kit (aorq)

Sums up what drinking and driving is all about. If you drink and drive you could do more than maybe just wreck you or your car. If someone is permanently injured or killed as a result of your actions, you've wrecked not only their life, but also the lives of everyone who cares about them. If you have to live with the consequences of that – you've wrecked your own life as well. Includes activities, resources and statistics.
