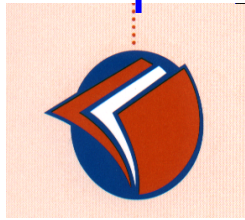

using a six step process that has been proven effective when approaching someone with an addiction. The loved one will also display ineffective and effective responses to these six steps. From time to time the action will stop and the narrator enters the picture and comments on the conversations and behaviours of the characters. The video tape provides the opportunity for viewers to:

- Learn the importance of addressing behaviours of concern in their early stages.
- Learn how to talk to a loved one that is suspected of engaging in risky, unhealthy or inappropriate behaviour.
- View approaches that are both not helpful and helpful when addressing someone who might be caught up in problem behaviour.
- Improve confidence about approaching a loved one.

Who are problem gamblers? Marion Rieger, a training consultant with Saskatchewan Health provides a historical overview of gambling, describes the recent expansion of treatment services, and provides definitions for terms related to problem gambling. Marion characterizes gamblers as having one of two motivations for gambling; action or escape. She describes gamblers as being one of six types, ranging from professional through social to the compulsive gambler. Marion finishes this segment by providing information on four essential features of behaviour which categorize an individual as a compulsive gambler.
