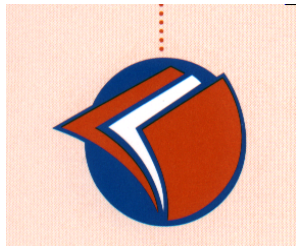

Seniors must be particularly careful about their drug use since drugs are distributed more slowly through the body and are not metabolized as in younger people. It is important that each individual take an active role in his/her health care and problems associated with psychoactive drug use by senior adults. It is aimed at both seniors and the people who work with them.
